Recently, I saw a t-shirt with the words: "I'm the most humble person I know." I had to chuckle at the humor of it—after all, someone truly humble would likely never be caught wearing such a shirt! Even today, in the midst of so much depravity and moral decline, we still recognize humility as an important virtue. That's why the shirt exists in the first place! Deep down, we want people to know how virtuous we are—even if announcing it actually costs us that very virtue.

Humility is a largely misunderstood virtue. Too often, it's mistaken for losing one's individuality, letting others walk all over us, having no strong opinions, or simply never taking credit for anything. But that is not authentic humility. As the saying goes: "Humility is not thinking less of yourself, but thinking of yourself less."

This strikes at the balance: we are called to uphold our dignity and even to have a degree of healthy pride in ourselves—but always held in check. And if we ever wonder how we are doing, all we have to do is look at the Cross. Jesus will show us whether we are on the right path, or if there is still a lot of work to be done.

May humility never become a competition, or need a slogan on a shirt. Let us embrace it as a virtue that helps us care for one another and place God in His rightful first place in our lives.
