If you've ever had the privilege of attending an ordination, you know it is one of the most powerful rituals in our Catholic tradition. One of the more striking moments comes when the ordinand lies prostrate in the church, face down before the Lord. It may look unusual, but the meaning is profound: that man is pouring out his entire life to Christ and His Church, surrendering himself completely to whatever service God asks of him.

Today's Gospel invites each of us into a similar act of surrender. Jesus speaks plainly: "Whoever comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, cannot be my disciple." Of course, He does not call us to literally hate our loved ones. Rather, He teaches that unless we are free from clinging to anything more than God—even good and beautiful things—we cannot truly follow Him.

That raises a question worth pondering: if the Lord were to ask you tomorrow to give up everything, your family, your possessions, or even your very life, could you do it? Would you be willing to pay the cost of discipleship?

This kind of surrender is not reserved for priests and religious. Every Christian disciple is called to lay down his or her life each and every day. To follow Christ means nothing less than giving ourselves completely to Him—trusting that in losing our lives for His sake, we will find them.


